The Real Academia de Bellas Artes de San Fernando is one of the most important Spanish Cultural institutions and is located at the emblematic Goyeneche Palace from 1773.

Nowadays it is composed by fifty six prestigious members from different Fine Arts fields and is structured in four departments, which complement the Museum: the Archive and Library, with an extraordinary number of documents and books on history and theory of arts; the Calcografía Nacional, center dedicated to the study and conservation of graphic arts, one of the three major collections of engraved copper plates in Europe; and the Workshop of Castings, which has remarkable historical sculptures in plaster, as classical models used in the training of artists.

The Museum is the second most important gallery in Spain and houses a collection of more of fourteen hundred paintings, some thirteen hundred sculptures and twelve thousand drawings, as well as prints, furniture, silver, porcelain and other decorative arts. The collection encompasses five centuries from Renaissance to most recent tendencies from 21st Century. It has fifty nine rooms hanging up Spanish, Italian and Flemish masterpieces of Art. Highlights include Goya's rooms, the only piece in Spain by Arcimboldo and masters such as Tintoretto, El Greco, Rubens, Ribera, Zurbarán, Van Loo, Sorolla, Zuloaga, Solana, Rusiñol, Juan Gris, Picasso o Tàpies, among others.

The Academy, situated at the heart of Madrid, is an ideal venue for your events; from intimate dinners or great receptions where your clients will enjoy an environment surrounded by valuable masterpieces of art. Goyeneche Palace offers you modern spaces such as the architectural and elegant Skylight Court, recently glazed for dinners and receptions, as well as classical and solemn Assembly Hall, ideal for Corporative and institutional events.

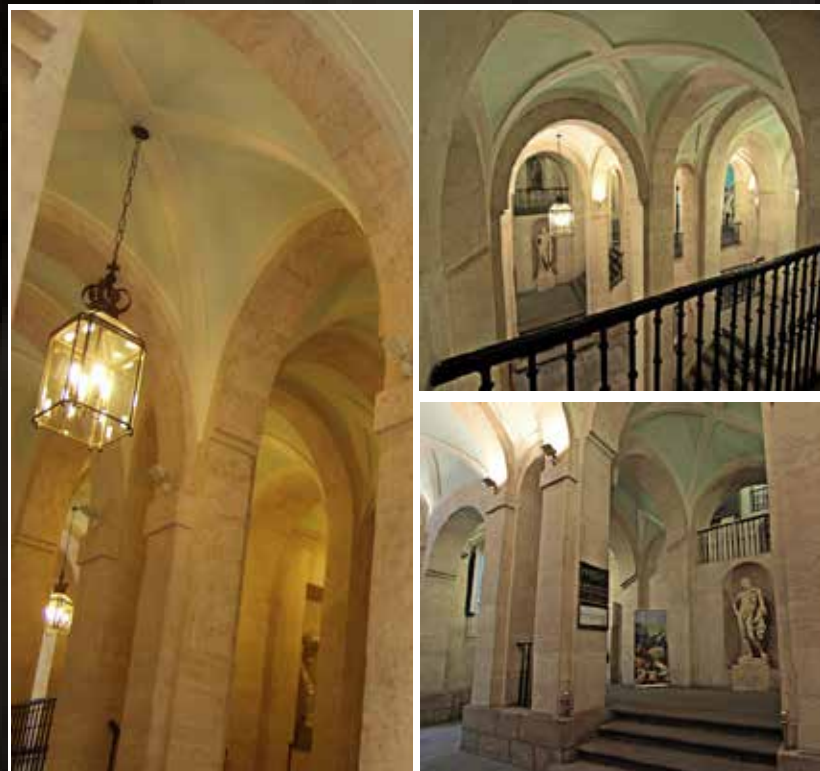


Museum Hall

At the top of the Monumental Stairs designed by Churriguera and recognised like one of the most beautiful barroque stairs in Madrid, you will find the Museum entrance Hall on the first floor. Decorated by 18th century paintings and flooded by natural light.

Sound table Behringer X32. Internal SDI cabling for video and XLR for audio. Dedicated 300/300 internet connection.

Audiovisual set-ups not included. Only two big screens are allowed on each side of the stage. Screens are also permitted in the following places:

- On the stage, 50 inches
- In front of the railing, 80 inches
- On both sides, 65 inches

With a wooden maciza table in agora shape, the Meeting Hall is decorated with a Spanish Kings Portrait Gallery. It is suitable for Direction Counsel Meetings, debates, presentation and round tables in an exclusive and solemn academic place, where you will find maximum privacy.

Resources: 6 led LG screens (5 of 42" and 1 of 55"), HDMI connexion and wireless distributor of video signal. HP Elite ProBook portable computer. Wooden atril? with microphone and flipchart.

Dimensions: 114 m² (9,5 x 12 x 4,35 m height)



Private Museum tours

The Royal Academy hosts one of the most prestigious collections of Madrid. Its three floors display Spanish, Italian and Flemish masterworks from XVI to XX Century. One of the highlights is Goya’s collection, member of the Royal Academy since 1780, within thirteen paintings by the artist considered the second best collection of Goya in the world. The exhibition shows the only Arcimboldo in Spain and masterpieces such as Tintoretto, El Greco, Rubens, Zurbarán, Ribera, Vicente López, Madrazo, Sorolla, Zuloaga, Solana, Rusiñol, Juan Gris and Picasso, among others.

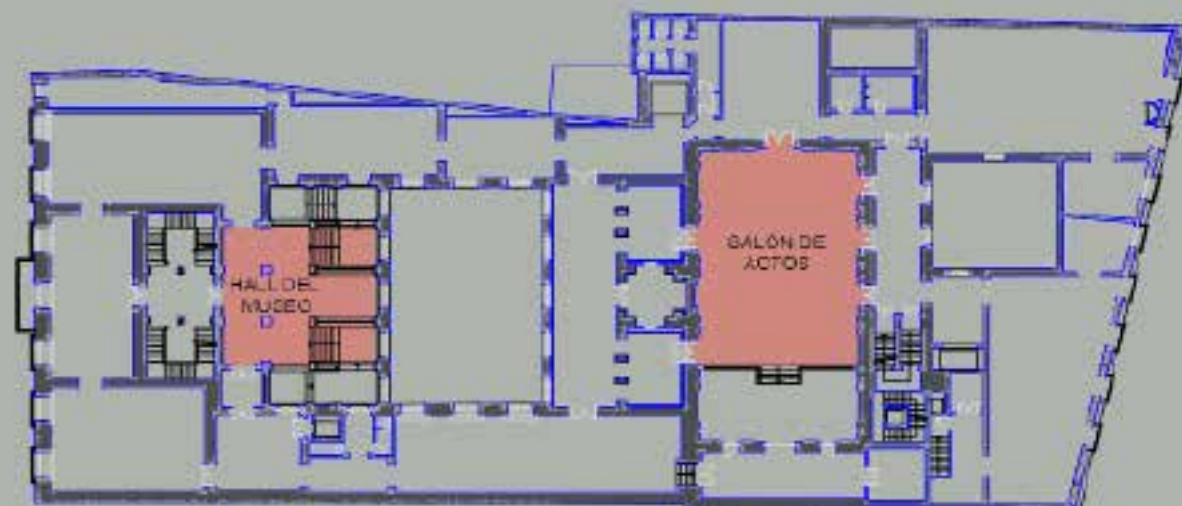

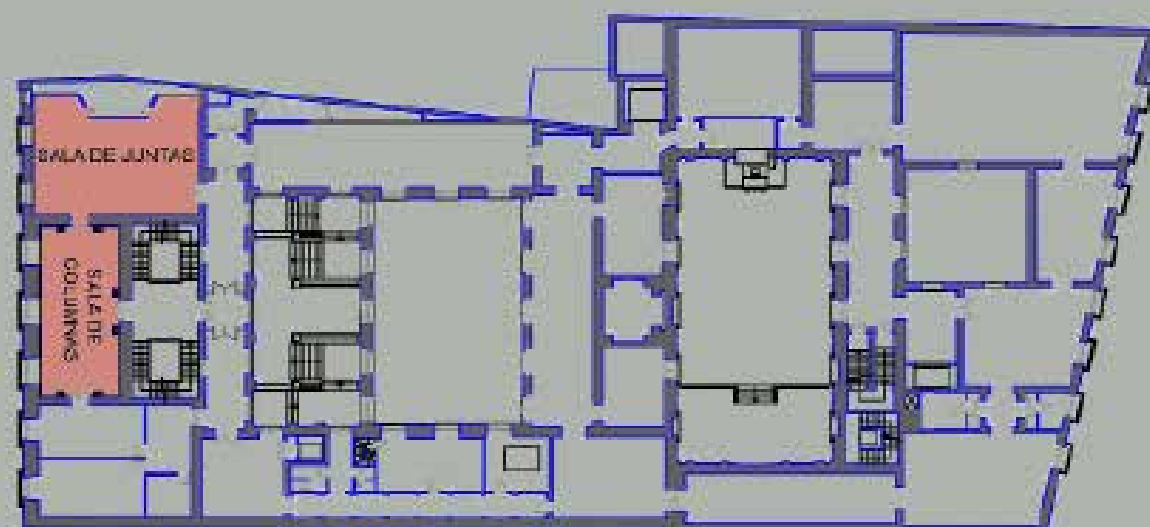

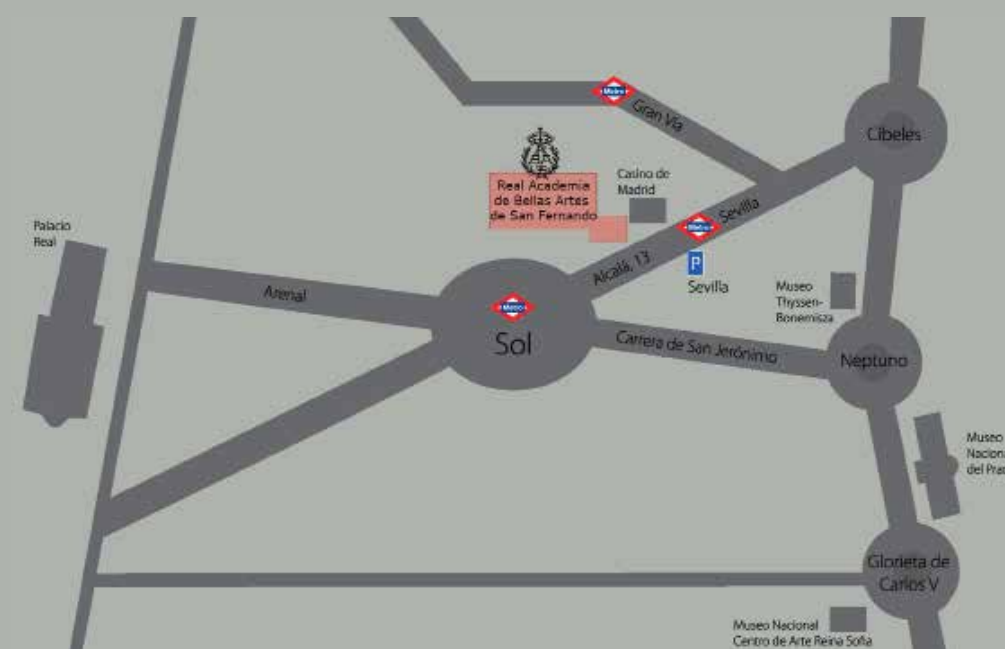
Ground floor
